- 1) We smell using our nose

- 3) We touch using parts of our body, like our hands.
- 4) We see using our eyes
- 5) We hear using our ears

Sense	Part of the body it is linked to
touch	fingers, hands, feet etc
sight	eyes
smell	nose
taste	tongue
hear	ears

Key Vocabulary

Human	All people are humans, men, women and children. We are animals that walk on two legs and speak using words.
Senses	Our senses tell our bodies about things around us by seeing, hearing, smelling, tasting or feeling.
Offspring	A person's children or an animal's young.
Adult	A fully grown animal or plant
Life cycle	The changes all living things go through to become an adult.

Animals, including humans have off-spring that grown into adults.
