Understanding the World

- The children will participate in weekly Welly Wednesday sessions in our woods which will include making animal dens and musical instruments.
- There will be lots of opportunities for ٠ children to investigate and talk about how and why things happen and work during busy times.
- We will look at changes that occur over • time, especially in the outdoor


