Key Vocabulary

Seed	a seed is a small, hard part of a plant that, when planted and given the right conditions, can grow into a new plant.
Bulb	a bulb is an underground part of a plant that stores food, allowing the plant to grow back later, like a mini plant waiting to grow, and examples include daffodils and tulips
Root	a root is the part of a plant that grows underground, holding the plant in place and absorbing water and nutrients from the soil

Prior learning:

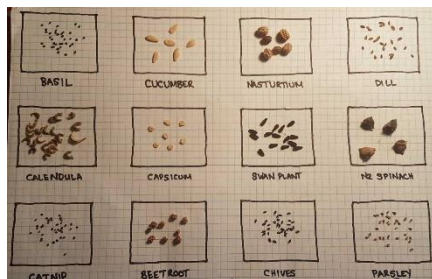
- Make observations about animals and plants.

Find out and describe how plants need water, light and suitable temperatures to grow and stay healthy.

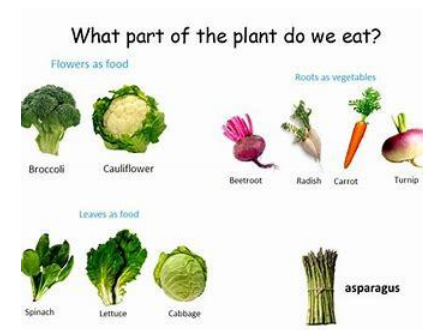
