

Bulb	a bulb is an underground part of a plant that stores
	food, allowing the plant to grow back later, like a
	mini plant waiting to grow, and examples include
	daffodils and tulips
Root	a root is the part of a plant that grows underground,
	holding the plant in place and absorbing water and
	nutrients from the soi
