### The UK



The UK is known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The UK includes England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.

**Great Britain** is an **island**. It is surrounded by **seas**

- to the south by the English Channel, which separates it from continental Europe.
- to the east by the **North Sea**.
- to the west by the **Irish Sea** and the **Atlantic Ocean**.

### Vocabulary

<b>Great Britain</b>	An island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales.
<b>Continent</b>	A very large area of land that includes all the islands with it. There are 7 continents. The UK is in the European continent.
<b>Ocean</b>	A large area of salt water.
<b>Capital City</b>	The city is where the government sits. London is the capital city of England and the UK.
