A note from Mr Hirani - We are halfway through the month and two weeks into another busy term. The children have settled well in to their routines and we continue to be impressed with their engagement and enthusiasm. It was a delight to be met by some very friendly animals in Year 4 this morning!

Last week saw 5P have their first swimming lessons, it was lovely to hear the positive feedback on how much they enjoyed their time learning and developing their skills.

This half term the value we are promoting within school is Respect. It is one of our core values and we would welcome it if you could spend some time thinking about how we can demonstrate and practice this in our everyday lives.

We will be looking at attendance in the weeks ahead. The last two years have been challenging for all and school attendance, during the pandemic, has not been robustly challenged externally. However, attendance is an area of focus once again for schools. We do need to work with parents where attendance becomes an area of concern. If your child's attendance falls below 90% it is classed as 'persistently absent'. We have no concerns where low attendance is due to cases of Covid-19 or other serious illnesses. However, where there are a significant number of unauthorised absences, we will contact you so that we can work together to improve your child's attendance. The DfE and the Education Welfare Department do require schools to take actions where attendance of individual pupils is a concern. A target of 96% is a measure of good attendance. Attendance at the school has been historically good but it has been an area of concern in the last few weeks. I would like to thank all those families who ensure their children attend school every day and are punctual.

Year 4 Topic Launch - Today in Year 4, the children all came to school dressed as an animal, as part of their topic launch. With the money the children donated, they are hoping to raise enough to be able to adopt an endangered animal through the WWF Charity. Brilliant effort year 4!





Next Thursday (20th January) is Census day, when our school meal numbers will be used to capture data for future funding. The Department for Education will use this figure to adjust our funding based on whether our uptake is above or below a set percentage. Therefore we hope that you can help to ensure the uptake of meals is as high as possible. We would be grateful if as many children as possible could have a school dinner next Thursday.
